PRESS RELEASE

NEW DELHI, JUNE 25, 2025: The Press Club of India (PCI), in association with 21 press bodies and over 1,000 journalists and photo journalists from across the country, has submitted a joint memorandum to Ashwini Vaishnaw, minister for Electronics and Information and Broadcasting (MeitY), in New Delhi, urging him to keep the professional work of journalists across print, online and electronic media, outside the scope of the Data Personal Data Protection (DPDP) Act, 2023. The concerns expressed in the memorandum were put together by the PCI after a close study of various definitions and provisions of the Act with legal and personal data experts. It was found that the Act comes directly against the journalists' fundamental right to work granted by Article 19 (1) (a) and (g) of the Constitution.

In the memorandum, the 22 press bodies located in various states expressed deep concern at the Ministry bringing journalistic work under its ambit, even though it was kept out at the drafting stage of the Bill.

The joint memorandum for the minister in-charge was submitted through Dharendra Ojha, the principal director general, Press Information Bureau (PIB) in New Delhi by PCI president Gautam Lahiri and secretary general Neeraj Thakur. "We submitted the memorandum yesterday through PDG and sought an appointment with the minister for clarification. The office of the PDG has confirmed that the memorandum has been sent to the minister's office. The PDG has promised to convey our message about the appointment to him. We are awaiting his answer, and hope the honourable minister will hear our arguments seeking the professional work of the journalists outside the purview of the Act. and clear the misgivings," Lahiri said.

The memorandum is part of a signature campaign initiated by the PCI in May, 2025, to press on the Ministry to bring about the crucial change in the Act, so that it doesn't hamper the work of reporters and photo journalists across print, online and electronic media.

PCI is extremely grateful to all the 21 press bodies for supporting the campaign.

Joint Memorandum

Cover Note

The **Press Club of India** along with **Press Club Hyderabad, State Press Club Madhya Pradesh, Delhi Union of Journalists, Indian Women's Press Corps, Press Association, Kerala Union of Working Journalists, Working News Cameramen's Association, Mumbai Press Club, Press Club Jammu, Kerala Press Club Delhi, Indian Journalists Union, Press Club Kolkata, Press Club Bangalore, Gauhati Press Club, Shillong Press Club, Chennai Press Club, Pink City Press Club Jaipur, Chandigarh Press Club, Arunachal Press Club, and Press Club Trivandrum (Thiruvananthapuram)** are submitting this memorandum to the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MEITY), signed by **1000+ journalists**, and **22 press bodies** comprising press clubs, unions, and media rights organisations from across the country.

This memorandum flags the concerns pertaining to specific definitions and provisions of the Digital Personal Data Protection Act, 2023, that have a direct and adverse impact on **press freedom** in general and **journalists in particular**, affecting the **rights granted under Article 19 (1)(a) and (g) [fundamental right to freedom of speech and the fundamental right to trade and professions]** of the Constitution of India.

Memorandum

A reading of the DPDPA in conjunction with the draft rules and expert opinion, points towards several highly problematic definitions and provisions that have serious repercussions for press freedom and the profession of journalism and reporting in India.

The DPDPA and draft rules fail to carve out exceptions/exclusions for journalists, who by the very definition of their work “collect”, “process” and “publish” information/data—both public and private—for the greater public good. The omission of journalists from the ambit of DPDPA makes every individual who collects any “personal information” liable for penalties under the stringent provisions of this Act.

1. Some of the contentious definitions are:

Section 2

(b): **“Automated”** means any digital process capable of operating automatically in response to instructions given or otherwise for the purpose of processing data.

(i) **“Data Fiduciary”** means any person who alone or in conjunction with other persons determines the purpose and means of processing of personal data.

(j) **“Data Principal”** means the individual to whom the personal data relates and where such individual is—

(i) a child, includes the parents or lawful guardian of such a child;

(ii) a person with disability, includes her lawful guardian, acting on her behalf.

(k) **“Data Processor”** means any person who processes personal data on behalf of a Data Fiduciary.

(t) **“Personal Data”** means any data about an individual who is identifiable by or in relation to such data.

Concerns

In the absence of any carve-outs for journalists and media organisations, all the above definitions will apply to both.

Example 1: Under the definition of “Data Principal” any person, who is the subject of any news report/article in which her name is mentioned or any other information which makes the subject identifiable, becomes a “data principal” and the journalist and the media organisation will be treated as “Data Fiduciary”. They will be subjected to the restrictive clauses under Sections 5 and 6 of DPDPA.

Example 2: According to the definition of “Data Processor” any journalist or media organisation using commonly available tools like Microsoft Excel, Datawrapper, etc., to tabulate and analyse any data becomes a “data processor” and will be subject to all the liabilities and penalties mentioned in the Act.

Example 3: The open-ended definition of “Personal Data” in effect means if a photojournalist takes a picture of an individual or a group of people during the routine course of work through which the subject/s in the picture can be “identified”, it will be considered as “personal data” and the photojournalist will be subject to all the restrictions and consent provisions underlined in this Act.

Our Demand No. 1

We, the undersigned, demand that the government should provide unambiguous clarity about the applicability of these definitions to journalists and media organisations. It should provide clearly outlined specific exceptions in each case for practising journalism in public interest as the definitions of, “data fiduciary” and “data processor” are applicable to them when they gather any, “personal data” about a, “data principal”. This will have the effect of requiring all journalists and reporters to seek prior consent from any person they report on, or whose “personal data” such as identification details are contained in a press report.

2. Issues arising from obligations of a Data Fiduciary

Section 5

(1) Every request made to a Data Principal under Section 6 for consent shall be accompanied or preceded by a notice given by the Data Fiduciary to the Data Principal, informing her of:

- (i) the personal data and the purpose for which the same is proposed to be processed*
- (ii) the manner in which she may exercise her rights under sub-section (4) of Section 6 and Section 13; and*
- (iii) the manner in which the Data Principal may make a complaint to the Board, in such manner and as may be prescribed.*

Section 6

(1) The consent given by the Data Principal shall be free, specific, informed, unconditional and unambiguous with a clear affirmative action, and shall signify an agreement to the processing of her personal data for the specified purpose and be limited to such personal data as is necessary for such specified purpose.

(3) Every request for consent under the provisions of this Act or the rules made thereunder shall be presented to the Data Principal in a clear and plain language, giving her the option to access such request in English or any language specified in the Eighth Schedule to the Constitution and providing the contact details of a Data Protection Officer, where applicable, or of any other person authorised by the Data Fiduciary to respond to any communication from the Data Principal for the purpose of exercise of her rights under the provisions of this Act.

Questions

A plain reading of these two Sections, in the absence of any exemptions, raises disconcerting questions, which are not answered either in the Act or the draft rules. A few sample questions highlighted below are illustrative examples to demonstrate the serious lacunae in the law.

Question 1: In a case of a developing news story such as coverage of a riot, a terror attack, or a natural disaster, is the reporter (data fiduciary) required to go through the elaborate process of obtaining consent from the victims (data principal) according to the provisions and clauses mentioned under Section 5 and Section 6 before reporting the story?

Question 2: In a case of a scam or instance of corruption perpetuated by a minister or bureaucrat or any public servant, is the reporter, or the media organisation, required to take “informed consent” from the accused in the form and format laid out in the Act, specifying the purpose for which the information has been collected, before publishing the article?

Question 3: In a case of custodial torture or death, is a reporter, or a media organisation, required to obtain consent in the prescribed format as defined under Section 6 of DPDPA from the accused police official before naming her, or mentioning the place of posting or where the incident took place, before publishing the article?

The DPDPA doesn't offer even a shred of clarity regarding the above questions. These questions are not merely hypothetical—they are routine to the process of news gathering and dissemination. A reading of sub-sections (1) to (3) of Section 5 in conjunction with sub-sections (1) to (10) of Section 6 of DPDPA evidences severe curtailment of press freedom and is ultra vires of Article 19(1)(a) and (g), as they impinge upon the basic fundamental right of the people to express themselves freely and the right to freedom of profession, subject to reasonable restrictions defined under Article 19(2) to (6) of the Constitution.

Section 7

(a) for the specified purpose for which the Data Principal has voluntarily provided her personal data to the Data Fiduciary, and in respect of which she has not indicated to the Data Fiduciary that she does not consent to the use of her personal data.

Scenarios

Scenario 1: Suppose a reporter is working on a story on denial of ration cards to people of a certain region due to mismatch with Aadhaar data and collects personal data of the affected people such as name, age, and place for identifying the extent of the problems. It raises some questions:

Is the reporter required to take “informed consent” from each individual for processing this raw data and using it in a coherent tabular format in an article to highlight the systemic problem in the public interest? Since this situation involves flaws that are inbuilt and baked into the Aadhaar architecture, does the reporter need “informed consent” of the concerned official of UIDAI before highlighting how Aadhaar-based ration cards are responsible for denial of food?

Scenario 2: Suppose, a few months down the line, it emerges that starvation deaths have occurred in the same region due to lack of access to food and the previously collected data is used to establish a causal link between the deaths and problems with Aadhaar data, is the reporter or the media organisation required to obtain fresh consent? Also, what happens if one (or more) of the affected persons dies, whose data has been previously collected—can that data still be used to highlight the plight of the affected people in the public interest?

Section 10

(1) The Central Government may notify any Data Fiduciary or class of Data Fiduciaries as Significant Data Fiduciary, on the basis of an assessment of such relevant factors as it may determine, including—

Question

Will a journalist, or a media organisation, investigating allegations of electoral roll manipulation, which contain personal data of voters, and constitutes a large volume of data, be notified as a “significant data fiduciary”? The law in its existing form is ambiguously silent regarding what qualifies as a large volume of data and how the status of a “significant data fiduciary” will be determined. The absence of well-defined steps in DPDPA for qualifying for “significant data fiduciary” status makes it arbitrary, and leaves it open to extensive misuse due to its potential for wide interpretation that can be used to infringe upon the practice of journalism.

Our Demand No. 2

It is clear from the reading of these Sections, sub-sections, and clauses, that they place significant restrictions on journalists and media organisations in practising the profession of journalism, besides giving unchecked powers to the instruments of the state to shut down all bona fide forms of journalism. We, the undersigned, demand that these sections, sub-sections, and clauses be suitably amended/removed to eliminate all ambiguities from DPDPA, which dangerously trample upon press freedom and freedom of expression under Article 19 (1)(a) of the Constitution. We demand that exemptions for journalists and media organisations be explicitly spelled out in the rules before they are notified.

3. Issues arising from Special Provisions

Section 17

(1) The provisions of Chapter II, except sub-sections (1) and (5) of section 8, and those of Chapter III and section 16 shall not apply where—

Clauses (a) to (f) of sub-section 1 under Section 17 lists the conditions under which certain types of entities have been granted exemptions.

(3) The Central Government may, having regard to the volume and nature of personal data processed, notify certain Data Fiduciaries or class of Data Fiduciaries, including startups, as Data Fiduciaries to whom the provisions of section 5, sub-sections (3) and (7) of section 8 and sections 10 and 11 shall not apply.

Issue with the wording of the Sections, sub-sections and clauses

While 'startups' have been categorically mentioned, which can qualify for exemptions, journalists and media organisations have not been categorically exempted. Does this mean that journalists and media organisations have to apply for exemption every time they deal with personal data in the practice of journalism for public interest?

Our Demand No:3

We, the undersigned, demand that journalists and media organisations be categorically exempted from the purview of DPDPA

4. Taking away protection of “sources” under Powers, Functions And Procedure to be followed by the Data Protection Board

Section 28

*(7) For the purposes of discharging its functions under this Act, the Board shall have the same powers as are vested in a civil court under the Code of Civil Procedure, 1908, in respect of matters relating to—
(c) inspecting any data, book, document, register, books of account or any other document; and*

Section 36

The Central Government may, for the purposes of this Act, require the Board and any Data Fiduciary or intermediary to furnish such information as it may call for.

Explanation

A significant part of journalism, particularly investigative journalism, relies on source-based information. Under globally established and accepted conventions and norms, protection of sources, including whistle-blowers, is one of the most sacred tenets of journalism. But the wide powers granted to the Data Protection Board under clause (c) of sub-section (7) under Section 28 and the unchecked powers available with the Central government under Section 36 take away all protection of confidential sources that are often used by journalists and media organisations in practising bona fide journalism. This is a gross violation of the right of journalists and media organisations to protect their confidential sources. This has grave consequences for press freedom.

Our Demand No: 4

We, the undersigned, demand explicit exclusion of journalists and media organisations from the purview of the random powers bestowed on the Data Protection Board and the Union Government that allows them to call for any information/data for violating Article 19(1)(a) and Article 21 of the Constitution of India.

5. Dilution of the Right to Information

Section 44:

(3) In section 8 of the Right to Information Act, 2005, in sub-section (1), for clause (j), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:—

“(j) information which relates to personal information;”

Implication

The dilution of Section 8(1)(j) of the Right to Information Act delivers a body blow to public interest journalism. The original clause, read as below:

information which relates to personal information the disclosure of which has no relationship to any public activity or interest, or which would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual unless the Central Public Information Officer or the State Public Information Officer or the appellate authority, as the case may be, is satisfied that the larger public interest justifies the disclosure of such information

This has now been diluted by the change caused through Section 44(3) of the DPDPA to such an extent in the garb of protecting personal data that it has taken away a vital tool from journalists, who have effectively used it to access difficult to access information, particularly information that impacts the everyday lives of people, for writing and broadcasting stories in the public interest.

Even a cursory research of the media will bear out the effectiveness and power of the unamended Section 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act in obtaining information and facts that have had a far-reaching impact in unearthing scams, public corruption, etc and placing them in the public domain. Even courts have relied upon information that has been placed in the public domain using this section of the RTI Act. For example, in the electoral bonds case (*Association for Democratic Reforms & Anr vs Union of India & Ors*), the Supreme Court relied on a volume of information that was accessed by using Section 8 (1)(j) of the RTI Act.

The unamended clause had sufficient inbuilt safeguards to prevent its misuse and it explicitly denied access to any personal information that was not in the public interest.

Our Demand No. 5

We, the undersigned, demand that the unamended Section 8 (1)(j) of the RTI Act be restored in totality because it has been one of the most effective legal tools for practising journalism in the public interest.
